Hello 2025 8-hour Ogres,

Race weekend is right around the corner! Thank you for signing up for what is going to be an incredible adventure in the wilds of Idaho, unlike any race you've done before! We can't wait to send you off into our favorite adventure playground in this stunning area.

8:00 - 8:45am: check-in, team pictures, and map pick-up 8:50am: pre-race meeting (mandatory for all 8hr racers)

9:30am sharp: race start

5:30pm: finish cut-off time. Awards and post-race celebration to follow.

CAMPING/AMENITIES

As you may have noticed, Birch Creek Valley is a remote place, which is why it is so cool. :) If you are choosing to camp on Friday or Sunday nights, plan to be self-sufficient. There are no nearby restaurants, gas stations, or shops. Camping is not reservable, but we have a couple group areas set aside and there are lots of dispersed sites available—there will be plenty of space for everyone! We will send out more specific camping details and a map in our next pre-race update.

GEAR

Please go through the <u>Gear List page</u> carefully, and note that there is mandatory individual and team gear, as well as recommended gear (some of which is *highly* recommended). Mandatory gear is the bare minimum of what you should consider packing.

**This year there will NOT be a designated transition area. Plan to carry everything you will need for the day, including lots of water!
